The Euro-Mediterranean network of the occupied and recovered factories, together with the trade union, political and social activists, organizes the Meeting and its self-organized funding. The Meeting mainly focuses on the recovery of production means and their management by working men and women. We invite all the experiences which share these topics, with a particular attention to those in the rural world and to the solidarity and alternative economy networks. We also invite researchers and members of social and political organisations, collectives and trade unions who recognise the workers' control of society and self-management as central political imperatives.

THE MEETING WILL BE ORGANIZED IN:

- **Plenary sessions:** the central fora of the meeting, these main discussions will not clash or overlap with other activities;
- **i workshops:** spaces for debates on practical and specific themes that will be held in parallel among each other.

The organizing group will coordinate the activities, with the aim of supporting the widest participation, and will collect proposals and suggestions that will be summarised in the closing plenary session.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

DATE AND VENUES:

The meeting will take place on 12, 13 and 14 April 2019 in the recovered factory **RiMaflow**, located in via Boccaccio, 1, in the municipality of Trezzano sul Naviglio, in the suburbs of Milan (Italy)

TRANSLATION AND INTERPRETATION:

Wireless simultaneous interpretation into Italian, English, French and Spanish will be provided during the plenary sessions; during the workshops, volunteer translators will support the discussions, according to specific needs. For the translation, we warmly thank the **Cooperativa detraducción Around the Word Translations**.

ACCOMMODATION: the participants can be hosted for free, with a sleeping bed, within the recovered factory RiMaflow. There will be enough toilets and showers. A limited number of rooms within other facilities of the Fuori Mercato network in the province of Milan, and in private apartments of comrades, are available. Such places will be reserved to participants coming from other countries and eventually with the greatest difficulties. These accommodations are for free; a small volunteer offer is requested for those who will be hosted in a room. Participants can book a room in hotels or b&b directly on the Internet. Nonetheless, please note that over the same days of the meeting, Milan's hospitality sector will be crowded due to a Fair. Hence, if you intend to do it, please reserve a room as soon as possibile.

FOOD AND DRINKS: basic vegetarian organic food for lunch and dinner will be provided by the self-managed kitchen of RiMaflow and Fuorimercato at 3 euros/meal. Breakfast will be available behind free money offer. During all the time the bar will be open.

SOLIDARITY: Stands to showcase products and materials presenting the activities of local and international solidarity projects will be set up for the entire duration of the meeting.
